TRAINING SCHEDULE

Safety during vehicle movement





- Acquisition of a state of mind and good overall preparation before field deployment.
- General convoy safety and security procedures, including SOPs and contingency plans.
- General safety procedures in case of lost orientation, lost communication, engine failure.



- Reacting to crowds and demonstration
